Level	Percentages are based on <u>190</u> school days in an academic year.	Days absent to date	% Year to date
GOLD	Your Child's attendance is 98% or higher – having less than 4 days absence <u>in a whole academic year</u> . As well as being an excellent attender, your child has every chance of achieving to their best ability.		
SILVER	Your Child's attendance is between 95 and 98% - this is less than 10 days absence <u>over the whole academic year</u> . Your child has the potential to achieve to their best ability.		
BRONZE	Your Child's attendance is below 95% - potentially missing more than 10 school days <u>in a whole academic year</u> that may never be recovered. Your child is now considered at risk of falling into the 'Persistent Absentee' category as outlined by the government. Further absence from school may result in your child be unable to achieve to the best of their ability. Your child's attendance will now be monitored closely.		
RED	Your Child's attendance is 90% or below and they are now considered a 'Persistent Absentee' - potentially missing over 20 days of school and learning over the school year. This amount of absence from school will make it hard for your child to catch up and understand new learning and may be affecting their friendships in school. It is possible that continued absence at this level <u>over the school year</u> could result in legal proceedings and financial penalty.
