



Primary School Sports Funding 2016-17

The Government is providing significant funding for primary school Physical Education and School Sport. It has been given directly to head teachers to spend on improving the quality of PE and School Sport provision.

At North Somercotes CE Primary School we are committed to providing high quality PE and Sport in school, good quality after school sports provision, providing the children with essential life skills and giving them opportunities beyond their usual life experience.

Our total funding for 2016-17 is a lump sum of £8000 plus an additional £5 per pupil. This equates to approximately £8800 and will be spent as follows to realise the aims of the funding:

Over the course of the year all children will receive specialist sports coaching from different specialists sports coaches from Grimsby Town Football Club and JB Sports Coaches. These sessions will be taught jointly with school staff and will be used to support staff development in the teaching of high quality PE and Sport. Regular after school sports provision will also be available to all children. **Cost: £5000 per year.**

Swimming is of huge significance to all children and we are fortunate to have our own pool on site. All children from Rec to Year 6 will swim at least twice a week during the final term of the year. Staff training will ensure full safety requirements are met and high quality provision is delivered. Our aim is that by the end of year 6 all children can swim at least 25m. **Cost £400**

First Aid is an essential life skill – all children will leave our school with official First Aid Certification. This will be led by experienced tutors and will take place when the children are in Year 5 or Year 6. This operates on a 2 year rolling programme. **Cost £400**

In addition to the traditional school sports we are committed to giving the children the experience of developing sports, including Paralympic style sports. This will give the children a real chance to try an emerging sport. In previous years this has included Archery, Bokwa and New Age Kurling **Cost £500**

Update and review PE Equipment in school. In line with PE/Sports Action Plan. **(Cost £500)**

In addition to this, we work closely alongside Caistor Grammar School and our partnership secondary schools, via the School Sports Partnership, which assists us to maximize the impact of this grant. The aim is to benefit pupils, parents and school staff. **Cost: £2400 per year.** *(Transport allocation of £500 will also be added to ensure a full and frequent involvement.)*

Role of the School Sports Partnership (SSP):

- **To provide an extensive range of professional development opportunities for staff:**

A comprehensive programme of primary school sport specific courses is organised, aimed at supporting school staff to deliver high quality PE and sport. There will be a minimum of 6 courses arranged per year in partnership with other SSP areas that include: gymnastics, dance, netball, athletics, quicksticks, cheerleading and football.

- **To provide specialist sports coaching and staff mentoring:**

In partnership with recommended Sports Coaching companies, qualified sports coaching will be offered to provide a comprehensive range of activities with local, dependable, qualified and DBS checked coaches, who will inspire pupils to continue in both the school and community setting. This supports the delivery of high quality PE and sports sessions by having well qualified sports coaches working with our school staff.

- **To co-ordinate a range of inter and intra school competitions and sports events:**

A competition calendar has been produced, offering many inter school competition opportunities through the year.

- **To ensure the expansion of school links to community sports providers:**

we will be providing weekly opportunities to participate and compete in school sport to enable pupils to attain high standards of performance. Through the initiative, pupils will improve fitness by keeping them physically active and engaging them in regular high-intensity vigorous activity for sustained periods of time.

- **Development of leadership opportunities and active playgrounds programme:**

we are going to train members of school support staff to deliver a leadership course around active playgrounds to pupils. This type of leadership enhances pupils' personal development and well-being.

- **To support monitoring, evaluating and evidence development:**

Mrs Knott/Mr Floyd will be supported to articulate a clear vision for PE, set high expectations of staff and pupils and support curriculum development in PE.

Total Spending planned £9700

2017-18 - Areas for Further Development

- Opportunity for new and exciting Outdoor/Adventurous provision will be extended to children in Year 4 – making use of local facilities.

Monitoring/Evaluation (*Governors Finance Committee + Governor with responsibility for PE and Sport – Mrs N Barton*)

- Ofsted inspection Feb '14 – 1 PE lesson observed led by sports coach with class teacher support. Lesson was graded Outstanding.

Leaders have used the additional money from the primary school sports funding to provide additional training for staff and to increase pupils' participation in sport. Attendance at the after-school sports club has increased since the beginning of September 2013. There are several sports events with other schools in the locality which pupils enjoy. These improvements and the school's award for 'Food for Life' contribute well to pupils' health and well-being. (Ofsted Feb '14)

- Excellent parent feedback regarding PE and Sports provision in school – recent questionnaire 100% positive with no development points regarding PE and Sport.
- Good attendance PE/Sport specific after school clubs.
- 100% of children in KS2 have competed in an interschool competition during the academic year. 100% have also competed at advanced facilities in a local secondary setting. Children have the opportunity to attend at least 3 local inter school competitions.
- Staff have received training regarding provision for 'able' children in PE – this has enabled us to meet the needs of these children.
- Through full engagement with the Wolds SSP staff are now teaching higher quality PE lessons – specific training in Dance, Athletics, Swimming and Outdoor/Adventurous Activities have led to increased proportion of good/outstanding PE lessons.

At North Somercotes CE Primary School, we are proud of the provision our pupils receive, whilst also recognising the potential to develop this. We actively encourage them to participate in after school sports clubs, as well as competitions organized by local sports clubs. The children are also encouraged to share and celebrate their success within Collective Worship. We have been awarded the Sainsbury's School Bronze Award and aim to achieve the Silver Award during the next academic year.
