Dance Provision

Following fantastic feedback last year we are again working closely with local dance teacher Mrs Helen Jones to provide all the children with **enhanced age-specific dance provision.** Mrs Jones will be working with each class over half a term to provide high quality and fun dance experience. **Themes range from Mini-Movers to Freestyle Dance to Performance Art.** These sessions take place on a Wednesday morning with Rec, Y1 and Y2 participating up until October half term. Y3 and Y4 in January up until February half term and the Y5 and Y6 sessions taking place from February half term until Easter. This is an exciting opportunity for all the children and is funded using our Sports Premium funding.
